Boarding House Program

Customized accommodation designed for international students to better adjust and transit to academic and social life in the U.S.

Our academically focused Boarding House Program aims to provide international students a boarding-school-like experience while having counselors living in the same house to assist students with academic needs as well as to guide them to adapt into the American school life.

Many international students find it difficult to live in a culture that is completely different from their own and at the same time have to learn the language in order to keep up with school work and make friends. Staying with a host family may be a bit intimidating for students who need more academic support and guidance. Thus, Boarding House is the perfect accommodation for them. Our students live with our counselors in a house located near their school. Since our Boarding House Program is academically based, we offer homework assistance/tutoring service on weekdays taught by an English native speaker who graduated from a prestigious university in the U.S. In addition, we provide TOEFL/ESL classes on the weekend in order to prepare students for university level course work.

Homestay Program

In order for our international students to receive local and authentic American cultural exchange experience during their education in the U.S., we provide Homestay Program to meet this goal. Our friendly and welcoming host families have had wonderful experiences living with our students. Students benefit from this program through everyday interactions with their host family, friendships building with host families' children and relatives.



To ensure the safety of our students, we make sure our host families are qualified before arranging students into their homes. Our host families have passed criminal background checks conducted by IntelliCorp, our visitation, and an interview. During our visitation, we take pictures of our host families' house and rooms to send to our international students and parents for confirmation of accommodation. Giving our students and families the best cultural exchange experience is one of our goals. Thus, we match the preferences of our host families and students including but not limited to gender of children, location, and meals arrangement. Host Family Program is available for both Summer/Winter Camps students and international students who are studying in the U.S. for academic years.

WINTER SCHOOLING CAMP



A Taste of Studying in the U.S.

Many international students often express interest in studying in the U.S. while worry that they may not be able to adjust to the culture, language, afraid of being away from their family, and are not sure if U.S. is the right place for them. To answer these questions, our Winter Schooling Camp is especially designed for students who would like to experience American education, learn the culture, and prepare themselves for the “actual” study abroad.

Winter Schooling Camp students usually come between December-February. They attend classes together with American students, participate in after-school activities, go on weekend sightseeings, and a 4-day-3-night Ivy League Colleges Tour. Our Winter Schooling Camp is academically focused to develop international students skills to foster capabilities and to get an insider’s guide to American culture through the shadowing of exemplary American students and staying with a host family. College Application Consulting

College applications can be a headache for many juniors and seniors. For international students, college applications are intimidating due to numerous requirements and documentations.

Therefore, EQ provides College Application Consulting service for students who need step-by-step guidance from college and major selection to application to confirming admission.

We suggest students to apply to as many as 10 colleges in order to provide students a variety of options that match their major choice and provide sufficient backup schools. EQ counselors first evaluate student’s transcript and achievements in order to understand the student’s academic standing. Counselors then sit with students one-on-one to discuss about colleges that students might already have in mind and their interests of study. They will then finalize a list of colleges and begin the application process. Many colleges require an application essay, which is one of the most crucial parts of the application as it reflects student’s writing skills, creativity, personality, experiences, etc. Thus, EQ counselors also proofread student’s essays and provide feedback. After submission of application, counselors keep track of the status of applications and then confirm admission together with student.

EQ’s College Counselors are all graduates from accredited universities in the U.S. and have college application consulting experience.
